Recommendation:

That the Committee accept this report as information and that the item be brought forward to a future Regular Council meeting for decision.

Issue: A volunteer committee was established to conduct a review of the Council Remuneration Policy and provide Council with recommendations on remuneration.

Background: The Council Remuneration Policy was approved in October of 2019. Upon review of the Policy, Administration established a volunteer committee to offer recommendations to Council on policy updates and remuneration.

A summary of the key changes include:

- Mayor's remuneration to be based on 64.4% of the total averaged salary of that of a Saskatchewan and Alberta Minister;
- Councillors' remuneration to be based on 38.2% of the salary of the Mayor.

No other substantial changes are proposed at this time.

It should be noted that the Council remuneration included in this Policy becomes effective following the November 2024 General Election.
